Export and import your profiles... share with your friends!

VoiceAttack can export and import profiles. Want to share your profile, but, don't want your friends to know ALL your secret moves? Export your profile with only the commands that you specify.

You can also import profiles with the same level of control... in case your friends' secret moves are really not that great :)

Exporting is also a useful way to back up your profiles. Just export and save to a safe place.
